Where does Herzl's revenue come from? Mostly from camp tuition, donations for services provided at camp, and a little bit from other gatherings at camp

75% Camper tuition
15% Donations for camper services
10% Unrestricted donations
>1% Retreats/Rentals at camp

- Transportation and security

Herzl has had a balanced budget since 2010 and eliminated all debt in 2019. We've always managed expenses tightly. That said, we will tighten our belts further with salary cuts, temporary and permanent staff reductions, and other cost cutting measures.
