## All Together Now: A Matching Grant for Jewish Camp

The Harold Grinspoon Foundation has committed up to \$10 million to participating Jewish overnight camps affiliated through its JCamp 180 program, listed below.

#### **Overview:**

Camps participating in the All Together Now matching grant for Jewish camp will be eligible to receive \$1 from the Harold Grinspoon Foundation (HGF) for every \$2 they raise from other donors beginning March 30, 2020, until December 31, 2020, up to a maximum based on camp size and utilization (1:2 match).

Should your camp not be open for some or all of summer 2020, or if a camper withdraws from the 2020 camp season, camper families may convert some or all of pre-paid deposits and tuition to a charitable donation to your camp for a dollar to dollar match (I:I match).

## Eligibility:

- All Together Now is offered to Jewish overnight camps affiliated with JCamp 180. A full list of
  eligible camps can be found at the end this document.
- The grant runs from March 30, 2020, until December 31, 2020.

## **Grant Usage and Match Amount:**

- Grant funds and donor gifts to this match are unrestricted and may be used toward the general operations related to any direct camp expenses.
- HGF will grant \$1 to the camp for every \$2 of qualified funds raised and received by the camp during the matching grant period (1:2 match).
- If a camp does not operate in full or in part during the 2020 camp season, or if a camper withdraws from the 2020 camp session, any pre-payments of deposit/tuition that a camper family agrees to convert to a donation to the camp will be matched dollar for dollar (1:1 match).
- Each camp has been assigned a maximum grant amount based on information reported in the annual Camp Census in 2019.

#### Gifts eligible to be matched:

- To be eligible for matching by HGF, gifts must be cash or cash equivalent.
   Stocks, bonds, and other cash equivalents will be matched.
- Gifts of any amount will be matched up to the camp's maximum.

### Gifts not eligible to be matched:

- In-kind contributions, discounts on services or goods, art, real estate, or other non-cash instruments will not be matched by HGF.
- Regular allocation from Jewish federations or similar agencies are not eligible to be matched.
   However, increases or special gifts made by federations or similar agencies responding to the COVID-19 pandemic are eligible.
- Government relief funds associated with the COVID-19 pandemic are not eligible.
- Restricted gifts designated for specific programs or capital expenditures are <u>not</u> eligible to be matched, <u>unless</u> the donor agrees to remove the restriction.
- If your camp is currently in another active HGF matching grant through JCamp 180, donations may only be submitted to one HGF grant to be matched.

## **Program Requirements and Payments:**

- Participating camps must complete an application through the Harold Grinspoon Foundation online grant management system.
- Camps must sign and submit a Grant Agreement Letter before any funds will be distributed. The letter will be generated in the online application process.
- The Harold Grinspoon Foundation will aim to disperse funds within 10 business days after submission/approval of proof of donor payments submitted in the online system. Total gifts submitted must qualify for a minimum of \$5,000 HGF matching funds disbursement.
- Disbursements may be made by wire transfer or by check.
- Upon the grant's conclusion, camps must submit a brief report including the number of donors, total amount raised, and how funds were used. Reports are due on or before February 28, 2021.
- All decisions for matching funds are at the sole discretion of the Harold Grinspoon Foundation.
   Terms and conditions are subject to change and/or termination at any time.
