

Chai Match 3 Rules and Eligibility

The **Chai Match 3** matching grant program of the Harold Grinspoon Foundation (HGF) provides momentum to experienced JCamp180-affiliated camps to allow them to continue to motivate their existing and new donors. To be eligible for participation in the **Chai Match 3** program, a camp must be a current client of JCamp180, may not have participated in Chai Match 1 or 2 and may not be a participant in any other active matching grant program. This restriction excludes from **Chai Match 3** all camps participating in the **Create Your Match 5**, **Meet Your Match 6** and **Create Your Match 6** programs. Interested camps must apply for, and be accepted into, the **Chai Match 3** matching grant program.

The *Chai Match 3* program is a two phase matching grant program. In the first phase, funds raised in a minimum amount of \$9,000 per gift are matched by HGF funds (up to a \$54,000 maximum) to form a larger pool of funds for phase 2. In phase 2, minimum gifts of \$1,800 are matched 1:3 from the combined phase 1 matching pool (up to a \$108,000 maximum). HGF Funds are provided to the camp on a pro-rata basis depending on the gifts received in Phase 2. Gifts received by participating camps <u>after November 2, 2014</u> will be eligible to be matched as part of the *Chai Match 3* program.

To be eligible for matching funds, contributions to the *Chai Match 3* program may include gifts from new or previous donors. Gifts in both phases may come from individuals, families (spouse, parents, grandparents, siblings and children), family foundations or corporations. Grants from a Jewish Federation, from the Foundation for Jewish Camp, or for a specific funded programs are excluded. At least 50% of funds raised must go toward capital improvements or facility enhancements. During the application process, camps must choose the Chai level at which they wish to participate.

To be considered for inclusion in this matching grant program a completed application must be submitted no later than September 24, 2014. All applications will be acknowledged within one week of submission. Camps are responsible for assuring that their application has been received. Camps chosen for participation will be notified by October 17, 2014.
