

Meet Your Match 6

JCamp 180, a program of the Harold Grinspoon Foundation, proudly announces **Meet Your Match 6**, a challenge grant program from **January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2016**. The program is intended to boost the efforts of selected affiliated camps to raise funds to improve their facilities and thereby enhance the Jewish camping experience. **Meet Your Match 6** follows other Grinspoon Institute challenges, which, since 2006, have helped Institute camps raise over \$60 million.



About the program

A sum of \$75,000 will be set aside for each eligible camp. Gifts of \$10,000 or more that are made in support of capital improvements only and meet all other grant requirements will be matched by the Harold Grinspoon Foundation at a 1:3 ratio to a maximum match of \$25,000 per gift. See chart below for illustration.

GUIDELINES

- Eligibility for *Meet Your Match 6* is open only to those camps that have been approved for participation in JCAMP 180 and have an assigned mentor (See *list below*).
- For a gift to be eligible for matching funds, a **new donor** must make a minimum gift of at least \$10,000 in a single pledge to a camp. A **new donor** is an individual, family, corporation, or foundation that has not made a pledge or gift of \$10,000 or more since December 31, 2011.
- For a gift to be eligible for matching funds, a **previous donor** of \$10,000 or more (made after December 31, 2011) must triple the size of the previous gift. A **previous donor** may be an individual, family, corporation, or foundation.
- Members of the same family may give a "combined" single gift of \$10,000 or more. "Family" is limited to spouse, parents, grandparents, siblings, and children. Family trusts, foundations, and corporations may also qualify as donors. Gifts from a Jewish Federation or the Foundation for Jewish Camp are not eligible.
- Donor gifts and matching funds must be used for **capital improvements**, defined as the following:
 - I. Construction of buildings or portions of buildings
 - 2. Major repairs to buildings or portions of buildings, but not maintenance
 - 3. Improvements to grounds, but not normal upkeep
 - 4. Major pieces of equipment
 - 5. Infrastructure construction or maintenance of septic and water systems
- Camp must submit a MYM 6 Application for every pledge to be included in the campaign, by the pledge deadline of **December 31, 2014**.
- The first payment of at least one-third of the pledge amount must be made within 60 days of the Application date, or the reserved matching funds will be released.
- Matching funds will be distributed on a quarterly basis (starting April 2014) based on the paid portion of pledge (must include copy of check or credit card receipt).
- All pledges must be paid in their entirety by **December 31, 2016**.
- All decisions for matching funds are at the sole discretion of JCamp 180 and the Harold Grinspoon Foundation. Terms and conditions are subject to change and/or termination at any time.
