

LEAP's goal is to build nonprofit Jewish camp capacity by providing customized training and support to Board Chairs and Vice Chairs to practice healthy, creative, and responsible governance.









Board Chairs and Vice Chairs (fiduciary or not) of day and overnight camps (participation limited to 8-12; first come, first served)

10-month program. Three multi-day retreats with individual/group check-ins in between.





In-person retreats. Virtual sessions. Virtual group and individual check-ins.
